Thematic day on the social aspects of lighting

Lighting strategies are today progressively implemented in the suburban zones of cities as well as in areas confronted with economic and social difficulties.

In partnership with the University of Liège (LEMA), the LUCI Urban Strategies Commission, led by the City of Liège, has explored these new projects and their social dimensions. Its work has led to the realization of a publication on innovative and exemplary experiences in social lighting, as well as a workshop on this theme.

These two events will be the highlights of this day with conferences, discussions and a "light happening"!

> Experiences in social lighting

This session will present some of the international experiences selected for the publication with presentations from researchers, lighting designers and municipalities.
